RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SCHELL VISTA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT ESTABLISHING THE FISCAL YEARS 2020-2021 AND 2021-2022 APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT FOR THE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Article XIII B of the California State Constitution restricts government spending of the proceeds of tax revenue by establishing limits on the annual Appropriations of Local Agencies, and;

WHEREAS, Section 7910 of the Government Code requires the Governing Body of each local jurisdiction to establish an Appropriations Limit each year by Resolution, and;

WHEREAS, on November 6, 2018, the voters of the Schell Vista Fire Protection District (the "District") approved a special tax levy in District Ordinance 2018/0801 OR, which authorized an Appropriations Limit increase, resulting in new District Appropriations Limit amount of \$1,900,000.00, and;

WHEREAS, in May 2020 and 2021, the California Department of Finance released Price Factor and Population Information that authorizes a 2.90% and 4.19% increase in the Appropriations Limit for the District for FYs 2020-21 and 2021-22, respectively; and

WHEREAS, due to COVID-19, the FY 2020-21 appropriations limit was not officially set when the Board adopted the budget, and so this item will both formally adopt the FY 2020-21 appropriations limit and the limit for FY 2021-22;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Schell Vista Fire Protection District that, pursuant to Article XIII B of the California State Constitution, the Fiscal Years 2020-21 and 2021-2022 Appropriations Limit for the Schell Vista Fire Protection District are \$2,036,041.14 and \$2,121,351.26, respectively.

THIS RESOLUTION was introduced at a meeting of the Board of Directors of the Schell Vista Fire Protection District held on the 5th day of October, 2021, by Director Finn, who moved for its adoption, seconded by De Petersen, and ordered adoption by the following vote:
